

BLINDFOLD RODEO

Course is approximately 75 feet by 75 feet with 6 stations (See description below)

Equipment:

- Golf Cart
- Stop Watch
- Golf Ball and Small Paper Plate
- 6 Stations (e.g. barrels or cones)

Objective: To complete the course in the shortest time with the least penalties.

Rules:

1. Driver and Co-Pilot must be opposite sex.
2. Driver is blindfolded. The Co-Pilot can give verbal instructions ONLY to guide the driver around the course.
3. Driver must circle around each station before going on to the next station. (Not a complete circle drive around the object.)
4. At the last station the couple will pick up a golf ball on a small paper plate and drive it back to the finish trying not to drop the ball. The plate must be held ONLY with one hand.
5. A 10-second **penalty** will be added to driving time for each station ran into, knocked over, or missed, or if the golf ball is dropped.
6. A 20-second **bonus** will be subtracted from total time if the ball is NOT dropped.
7. Final time will be the time taken to navigate the course plus the penalties and minus the bonus.
8. Winner is the team with the lowest final time.

Description of course:

On a field approximately 75 feet by 75 feet, six obstacles will be placed in two columns with three obstacles in each column. The driving team will start at Station 1, loop around it and across to Station 2 then on to Stations 3, 4, and 5 looping around each. Then crossing over from the top of Station 5 to the top of Station 6 the team will pick up the golf ball on the paper plate and drive straight down the outside of the course to the finish at the bottom of Station 2.
